

The Rules

The present rules define the use of the Maisel network for the members of the MiNET association.

Application field

This regulation is based on the law n° 88-19 of the 5th of January, 1988 relating to the data-processing fraud, the law of the 3th of July, 1985 relating to the protection of software and the law n° 85-660 of January 6, 1978 relating to computer science, files and freedom. It applies to all of the members of the association MiNET who use data-processing systems connected to the Maisel network. The following data-processing systems are concerned :

- the systems of the association
- the systems of Telecom SudParis & Telecom Ecole de Management (S2IA or others departments)
- all systems to which it is possible to be connected from the TSP & TEM.

Access conditions to the network system

The access right to the data-processing systems is personal and inalienable. The recipients of a password commit themselves not to reveal it and not to give free access to their data-processing account to any unauthorized person.

While using the MiNET network, the user shall restrict his usage to educational, research and leisure activities. Without preliminary authorization, these resources cannot be used for projects financed by an external support which have not been validated by the board of the MiNET association, after consultation by the direction of TSP & TEM.

The members of MiNET only have access to the Maisel network (to education and research networks too) for which a password was delivered. They agree to use their access rights only within the exclusive framework of teaching or leisure activities and not to misuse the data-processing resources and networks at their disposal. The limits of the member's rights are defined, and may be modified during the year, by the persons in charge of the MiNET association which have delivered an access right, or by the persons in charge of the data-processing systems of TSP & TEM.

The right of access to the data-processing systems of MiNET is granted to a user only under the condition that he gives to the MiNET association his signature at the bottom of the present declaration, stipulating that he has read and understood these data-processing rules and the other texts of laws mentioned above, and also that he has paid the contribution for the MiNET association corresponding to the chosen period of time.

The right of access is granted to the members for the duration of up to five months at a monthly rate or a year at a yearly rate. The yearly access is actually 360 days long. The right of access is limited to MAISEL tenants. The direction of the TSP & TEM has the right to refuse any connection, and the MiNET association shall respect the decisions which could be made by the management.

Confidentiality of information

The user of the data-processing systems should not try to read, copy or modify the files belonging to the other users or to the data-processing systems of MiNET or TSP & TEM, unless explicitly was granted. It's also forbidden to try to intercept any private communication between other users.

Ownership and license rights of software

It is forbidden for any user of the data-processing systems to make copies of any software placed at his disposal, except for those falling under public domain or which are freely available; or to use it without conforming with the regulations of their authors or company who place them at the disposal of the MiNET association. It is forbidden to install pirated software on the devices provided, or any software for which the MiNET association does not possess a license, or in the case of website licenses, software for which the maximum allowed number of copies has been reached.

He is forbidden from using the servers' storage drives for the spread or storage of pirated software.

Use of the information processing systems

The user of the data-processing systems shall not:

- use accounts other than those for which he was given an access right
- carry out operations with the purpose of deceiving other users regarding his identity
- attempt to appropriate or to decipher the password of another user ;
- attempt to limit or to ban the access to the data-processing systems of authorized users
- introduce and to diffuse data-processing viruses
- use his account(s) to attack other data-processing systems or networks connected to the Maisel network

Use of the data-processing networks

Any user of a data-processing network commit himself not to carry out operations which could have as consequences :

- an interruption of the normal operation of the network or one of the systems connected to the network (computers, printers, routers, etc)

- to gain access to the private information of other users on the network
 - to modify or destroy information on any system connected to the network, with the exception of the user's own devices, and of data to which the user has explicit modification or suppression rights
 - to require human intervention or the deployment of additional technical means to bring them under control or delete them
- The volume and the nature of the information exchanged on the networks mustn't violate the terms which can be enacted by the persons in charge for the data-processing systems of MiNET or of TSP & TEM.

Some security rules

The user is responsible for the security of his own devices. The association thus strongly recommends keeping his devices up to date as well as the usage of an anti-virus software if available.

The user shall never connect a device which wasn't declared by the infrastructure deployed by the association.

Usage of a WiFi router without authorization by MiNET may be punished by sanctions including immediate shutdown, effective until the end of the year.

Any usage of the network -for exemple peer to peer downloading- which violates copyright laws, or specifically the 2009-669 law of june 12th 2009 regarding the spread and protection of creative content on the internet, will be immediately punished by immediate shutdown.

Any sanction put forward by the law linked to the illegal downloading of protected content will be applied to the concerned user, who is considered sole responsible for his actions. Additional sanctions may be applied by the TEM & TSP disciplinary board.

Specific rules

The administrators, members of MiNET association board, or active members who, by their function, have additional rights granting them access to confidential information are held to observe professional secrecy and any security instructions emitted by the person in charge of the network for the association MiNET. They shall abstain from any intervention which may compromise the safety and the proper operation of the data-processing systems of the Mines association. Only the MiNET president and the Director of the TSP & TEM are authorized to waive professional secrecy.

Applicable sanctions

Any user who will transgress the present rules is liable, in agreement with the gravity and the nature of the infraction, to be subjected to the following sanctions:

- an interdiction of connection for a duration from one week to one month
- an exclusion from the MiNET association, with an immediate disconnection
- internal sanctions from TSP & TEM which may include convocation before the disciplinary board
- penal legal proceedings.

I acknowledge awareness of these rules (which I keep safe) and I will respect them.

Furthermore, I know the legal measures which are applied in France, particularly those which concern the juridical protection of software (law no 92-597 of the 1st of July, 1992 relating to the intellectual property code, modified by the law no 94-361 of the 10th May, 1994) and curbing the attacks to data-processing system (law no 92-685 of 22th of July)

Special authorizations

I authorize the MiNET association to freely diffuse amidst its members the between linking my name and my computer name, to keep the associations between my name and the MAC addresses registered to my account on the deployed infrastructure, until the end of my lodging or schooling under TSP & TEM, the longest of the two being the one in effect. I authorize MiNET to collect, analyze and delete via automated systems the data generated by the automatic connection of a device or roaming on the network, in order to help detecting connection and/or configuration errors, hardware errors, and to help the detection of fraud and/or dodging.
